

RESEARCH CHECK-IN – CHECK YOURSELF!

Good research involves noting down analysis and facts. Include comments on author's credibility, rhetoric, etc. in your research. Are you meeting minimum expectations for 2 differing primary sources? They need to be substantial enough to complete the source evaluation!

Research Tip of the Week

Use your OPCVL skills to help determine a source's <u>credibility</u>.

CONTENT: Check for endnotes or footnotes that show the sources the author used. Did the author cite their sources?
